Devil's Corner Pinot Noir <i>Tasmania</i>	28	8.0	Shows layers of dusty cherry, well integrated spices and subtle oak on the palate. A generous savoury and seductive palate with a light astringency. Very interesting cool climate Pinot packed with great value.	92/100 *1	
Pepperjack 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon <i>Barossa, SA</i>	28.90	8.0	The dark purple colour and thickness as you pour should give the game away. This is a rich and powerful beast, exhibiting fragrant dark plum, black currant, mint and a sprinkle of aniseed and pepper spice. The opulent fruit has a vivacity and freshness which acts as a counterpoint. Serve with prime cuts of red meat.	92/100 *1	
Pepperjack 2016 Shiraz <i>Barossa, SA</i>	28.90	8.0	Big bold fruit, a touch of pepper on the nose with plums and blackberries on the tongue. Subtle tannins underneath but definitely for drinking now.	92/100 *2	

Philip Shaw Conductor Merlot (The Character Series) <i>Orange, NSW</i>	35	10.0	Leafy green pepper, blackberry, juicy, leafy, sappy, soapy. Soft leather, slight VA, and spicy. Intense, yet translucent. With soproessa, shows herbaceous fat and garrigue.	90/100 *3	
Pig In The House Organic Cabernet Sauvignon <i>Cowra, NSW</i>	28	8.0	A deep ruby with bright purple hues. A lovely balance between red and blackcurrants, with an underlying crushed herb character. The palate displays a fruit forward style of Cabernet, without being a mouthful. A touch of dry tannins provides the wine with medium bodied savouriness, contributed to by older oak tannins.	91/100 *2	
Pig In The House Organic Shiraz <i>Cowra, NSW</i>	28	8.0	Bright and fresh varietal characters of plum, berry fruits and spice well balanced by American oak maturation.	92/100 *1	
Rosnay Organic Cabernet Sauvignon <i>Canowindra, NSW</i>	26	7.0	Light colour, but has retained good hue, a very pleasant light - medium bodied wine, with cassis, plum and red and black cherry fruit flavours, tannins out of the frame.	88/100 *2	
Rosnay Organic Freedom Red <i>Canowindra, NSW</i>	26	7.0	Preservative free, a perfect blend of Shiraz (50%) Mourvedre (35%) and Grenache (15%). Crimson with purple hues. Aromas of raspberry and liquorice. Flavours of blackberry, cassis and dark plum with well integrated spicy tannins. Suitable for vegans.	89/100 *4	
Running With Bulls Tempranillo <i>Barossa Valley, SA</i>	30	8.5	Scarlet red in colour, aromas of cola, crushed herbs and black cherry with hints of clove and tomato leaf. A silky and savoury palate, showing black cherry and pomegranate with fine liquorice like tannins.	95/100 *4	

Stolen Block Cabernet Sauvignon <i>Clare Valley, SA</i>	16	5.0	From the wine region of Watervale in the Clare Valley. This fruit is blended with other premium parcels then matured with a combination of French and American oak for 15 months. With a generous nose of ripe blackcurrant, the palate bursts with juicy dark fruits and a hint of vanilla with lingering silky tannins.	60/100 *4	
Swinging Bridge Pinot Noir <i>Orange, NSW</i>	38	10.5	Brick red in colour with a floral, berry perfume and a smooth taste of cherry and a hint of cassis and violet. A medium body excellent with crispy peking duck or pancakes.	97/100 *4	
The Mill Shiraz <i>Windowrie, Cowra</i>	28	8.0	2016 NSW Wine of the Year. Gently spicy aromas include dark plum, blackberry and chocolate and a little earthiness. Medium bodied with soft but positive tannins, it drinks very well young.	93/100 *3
