Brown Brothers Moscato <i>Milawa, Victoria</i>	275ml 8.0		One of Australia's favourite Moscatos, a delightful reminder of the warmer months. Aromas of musk and freshly crushed grapes. Wonderfully spritzy on the palate, this aromatic sweet white has abundant flavours of sherbert and crunchy tropical fruits.	96/100 *6	
Jacobs Creek Sauvignon Blanc <i>South Australia</i>	n/a	6	Lively fruit flavours of passionfruit and citrus prevail across the palate, enhanced by the fresh natural acidity which provides vibrancy and length on the finish.	91/100 *6	
La Bohème Act Two Rosé <i>Yarra Valley, Victoria</i>	30	8.5	A majestic pale salmon colour in the glass, followed by lifted aromas of subtle strawberry and even notes of pomegranate and marzipan. The palate is crisp, generous with a superb long length. A wonderful wine to enjoy in the warmer weather or as an aperitif all year round.	91/100 *3	

Matua Sauvignon Blanc <i>New Zealand</i>	40	10	Succulent, fleshy peach and nectarine flavours are accented by key lime, mango and ruby grapefruit notes. Shows nice intensity on the long, expressive finish.	90/100 *1	
Pig In The House Organic Chardonnay Sauvignon <i>Cowra, NSW</i>	28	8	Pale straw in colour. Varietal aromas of lifted yellow peach and pear are evident. The palate of the wine is lively and refreshing with notes of nectarine, lemon and peel. The wine is well structured (acid balance).	94/100 *2	
Pig In The House Organic Rosé <i>Cowra, NSW</i>	28	8	Really pale pink in colour, clean, clear strawberry and watermelon juice flavours, though the wine finishes dry even with that fruitiness ricocheting in the palate. Tingly acidity does a good job of getting the palate racing too. Pretty, floral, red berry perfume. A touch of yeasty funk.	91/100 *4	
Stolen Block Riesling <i>Clare Valley, South Australia</i>	16	5	This Riesling is sourced from our elevated vineyards in the Clare Valley and has a lifted floral bouquet of blossom and honeysuckle. With flavours of crunchy green apple, fresh lime and lemon, this wine is finished with crisp balanced acid and is best enjoyed chilled.	60/100 *6	
Swinging Bridge Mrs Payten's Chardonnay <i>Orange, NSW</i>	42	10.5	Pale lemon, peach, citrus, almond and vanillin oak. Smooth and creamy with a decadent mix of citrus and stonefruit, vanillin oak support, velvety mouth feel and fresh acidity.	96/100 *2	
Swinging Bridge Pinot Gris <i>Orange, NSW</i>	30	8.5	Bold yellow, warm pear juice and apple with white melon fullness. Deliciously velvety and soft with excellent varietal definition, peach tea like depth and a umami finish.	91/100 *1	

Swinging Bridge Sauvignon Blanc <i>Orange, NSW</i>	30	8.5	Less contact and a small portion barrel fermenting process has made a subtle but positive contribution to this crisp wine, welding the mix of herbal and tropical fruits into a seamless whole.	94/100 *2	
Tamburlaine Sauvignon Blanc <i>Hunter Valley</i>	24	6.5	Fresh passionfruit and lemongrass aromas. Ripe passionfruit and crisp kiwifruit with hints of green apple freshness and a clean lingering finish. An excellent accompaniment to fresh seafood and light salads. The perfect wine for a summer barbeque.	94/100 *2	
The Mill Sauvignon Blanc <i>Windowrie, Cowra</i>	28	8	The palate is generous and full, with zippy acidity, passionfruit and gooseberry, complemented by a balanced citrusy acidity.	93/100 *5	
Windy Peak Pinot Grigio <i>South Australia</i>	22	6	Light straw in colour with green tinges. Honey and hay aromas typical of Pinot Grigio with a refreshing palate of herbal fruit flavours. The Windy Peak label always provides value for money and this wine is no exception.	91/100 *6


